1856 Tris set out to Lake Village, Ark. with his brother-in-law,
Christopher Columbus (Bud) Cain. Tris came back to Amite Co.
in the spring of 1857 to take his wife, Elizabeth (Lizzie) and little
Eula back to Arkansas with him. After the death of his first wife
and prior to their move to Arkansas, David Burton was placed in
the care of Abilene Bates's parents. He was raised by them. One of
the first things Tris did on each visit back to Amite Co. was to go
